

COPYRIGHT ACT NOTIFICATION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. GENERAL

The Copyright Act (Chapter 63) of Singapore and its subsidiary legislation (collectively the “**Copyright Legislation**”) limits the liabilities of network service providers (NSP) such as Liberty Wireless Pte. Ltd. (“**Circles**”), in respect of various services provided such as transmission, routing, provision of connections, system caching, storage of electronic material and/or online linking under the circumstances prescribed in the Copyright Legislation.

As such, Circles (as an NSP) will not be liable for any copyright infringements under the circumstances stipulated in the Copyright Act, so long as Circles has complied with the relevant conditions imposed therein.

However, if you are of the view that copyright in your material has been infringed in accordance with the Copyright Act, you may send a take-down notice (“**Take-Down Notice**”) in the form (or substantially the form) prescribed in the Copyright Legislation, to Circles’ nominated representative at the contact details below. Once Circles receives a valid Take-Down Notice, Circles will take reasonable steps to remove or disable access to the allegedly infringing material in accordance with the Copyright Legislation. In certain circumstances prescribed under the Copyright Legislation, once the allegedly infringing material has been removed, or access to it has been disabled, Circles will take reasonable steps where required to notify the person who has made such material available (“**Respondent**”). The Respondent may send a counter-notice (“**Counter-Notice**”) in the form, and in accordance with the relevant requirements, prescribed in the Copyright Legislation, to Circles’ nominated representative at the contact details below to restore the material. Such Counter-Notice must be sent within the time period stipulated in the Copyright Legislation. Upon receipt of such Counter-Notice, Circles will, in accordance with the Copyright Legislation, take reasonable steps to restore the material or access to that material (as the case may be), if it is technically and practically feasible to do so, except where court proceedings are commenced by the copyright owner to prevent that material, or access thereto, from being restored, and Circles is informed in writing of such proceedings.

Please note that Circles’ nominated representative should only be contacted for notifications under the Copyright Legislation, and not for other enquiries.

2. TAKE-DOWN NOTICE

If you are sending a Take-Down Notice, you must sign your Take-Down Notice, which must contain all of the following information (in addition to any other information required under the Copyright Legislation):

1. Your name, address, telephone number, facsimile number (if any) and email address, as well as the address for service in Singapore if you are not resident in Singapore;
2. Sufficient particulars to enable Circles to identify the allegedly infringing material and its online location;
3. A statement that you require Circles to remove or disable access to the material;
4. A statement that you, in good faith, believe that the material is an infringing copy;
5. A statement that the information in the Take-Down Notice is accurate;
6. A statement that you are the copyright owner or exclusive licensee or that you are authorized to act on behalf of such owner or exclusive licensee; and
7. A statement that you agree to submit to the jurisdiction of the courts in Singapore.

3. COUNTER-NOTICE

If you are a Respondent sending a Counter-Notice, you must sign your Counter-Notice, which must contain all of the following information (in addition to any other information required under the Copyright Legislation):

1. Your name, address, telephone number, facsimile number (if any) and email address, as well as the address for service in Singapore if you are not resident in Singapore;
2. Sufficient particulars to enable Liberty Wireless to identify the material that has been removed or to which access has been disabled, and its online location prior to such removal or disablement of access;
3. A statement that you, in good faith, believe that the material was removed, or access to it was disabled, as a result of mistake or misidentification, or that such material does not infringe the copyright in any material;
4. A statement that the information in the Counter-Notice is accurate; and
5. A statement that you agree to submit to the jurisdiction of the courts in Singapore.

4. YOUR RESPONSIBILITY

- 4.1 It is your responsibility to check and comply with the requirements of the current Copyright Legislation in respect of and in connection with the subject matters covered in this Copyright Act Notification Terms and Conditions. Circles reserves the right not to entertain any correspondence that does not comply with the requirements of the current Copyright Legislation and these paragraphs.
- 4.2 Please note that under the Copyright Legislation, a person makes a statement that is false, which he/she knows is false, or which he/she does not believe to be true, and which touches on any material point in such a Take-Down Notice or a Counter-Notice, then he/she:
 1. May be guilty of an offence and if convicted, can be fined up to S\$10,000 or imprisoned for up to 2 years; and
 2. Shall be liable for damages to any person who suffers any loss or damage as a result of such Take-Down Notice or a Counter-Notice.
